2023 - 2024 OPEN HOUSE

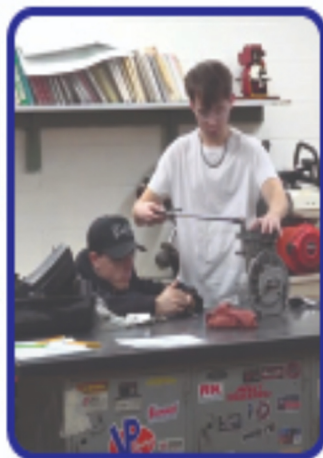

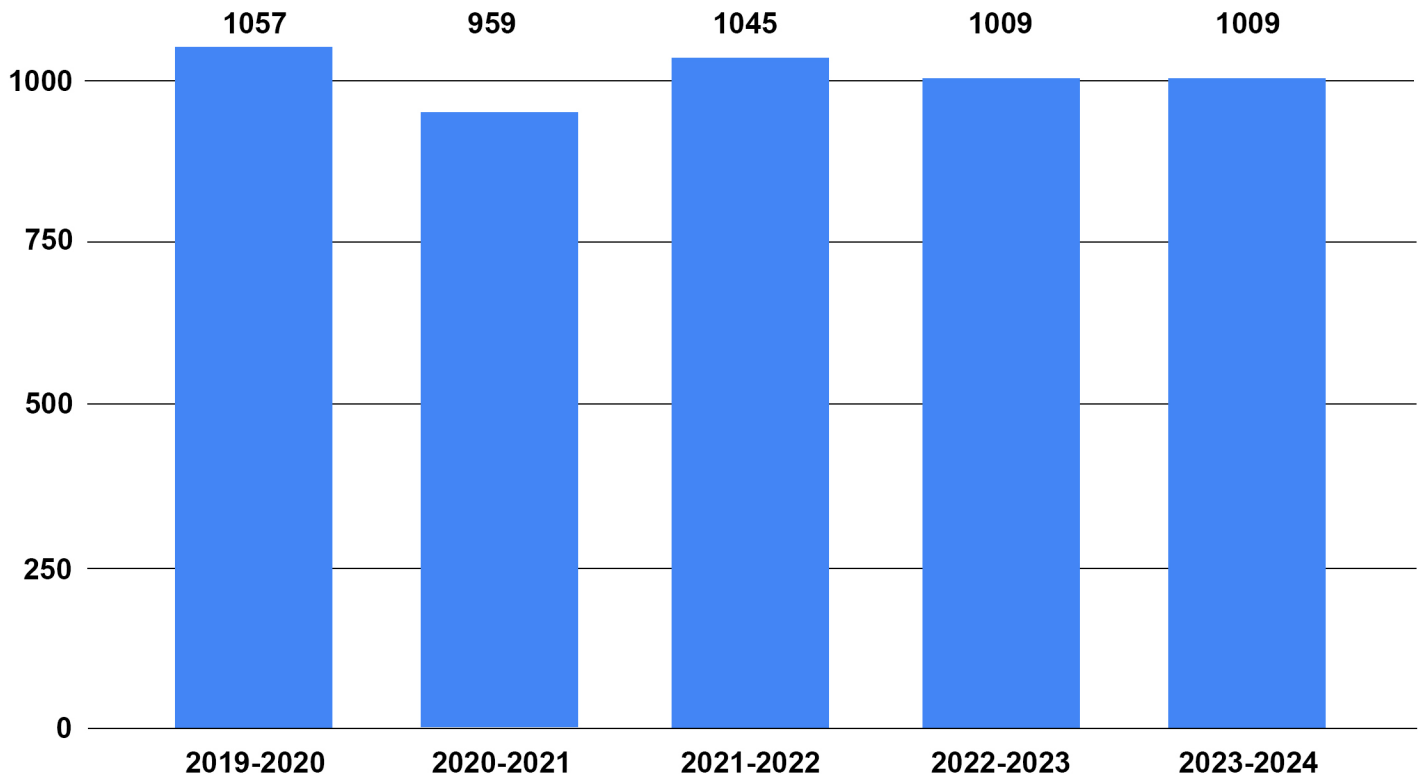

2021-2022 = 1,045 CTE students out of 3,447 total students = 30.3%

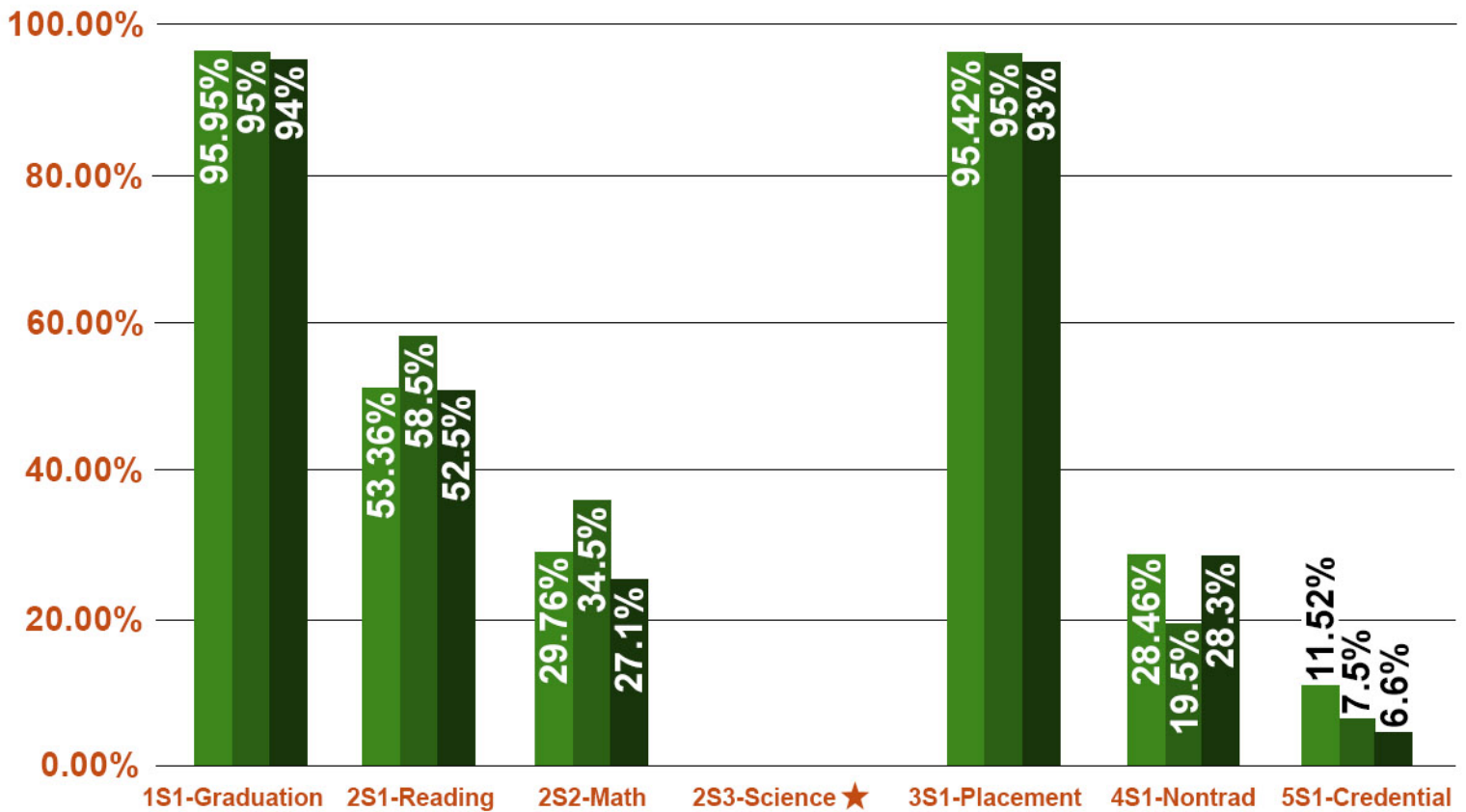

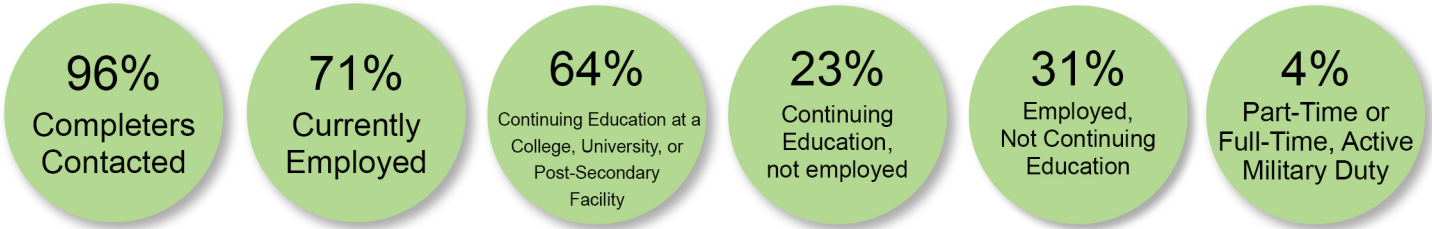


FIVE YEAR TREND

The BPA Regional Leadership Conference was held Saturday, January 20, 2024, at Central Michigan University. Over 500 students from 17 Lower Peninsula high schools participated in over 65 contests. HEALTH SCIENCES CAREER CLUB



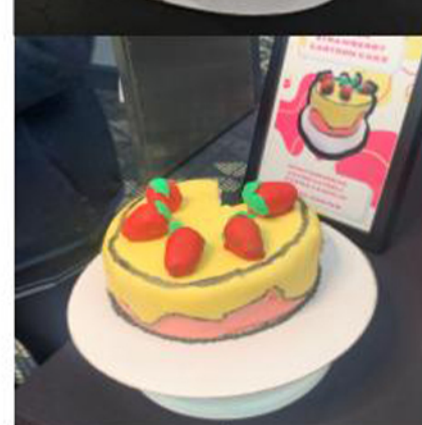
